



Short bio of Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. Gordon Thomas Rohrmair
Representing Hochschule Bayern e.V. in UAS4EUROPE

Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. Gordon Thomas Rohrmair has been President of the Technical University of Applied Sciences Augsburg (THA) since October 1, 2016.

Rohrmair studied Business Informatics at the former Fachhochschule Augsburg. After graduating in 2000, he completed a Master's degree in Computer Science at Heriot-Watt University in Edinburgh in 2001. From 2001 to 2005, Rohrmair pursued his doctorate at Oxford University, focusing on "Using Communicating Sequential Processes to Verify Security-Critical Applications."

After working as a strategy consultant at Stern Steward and as a project manager at Siemens, he was appointed Professor of IT Security at Augsburg University of Applied Sciences in 2009. Before assuming the presidency in 2016, he served for six years as Vice President for Research and Knowledge Transfer.

Rohrmair completed the General Management Program at Harvard Business School in 2022 and is a member of the Harvard Alumni Network. He is Chairman of the Mechatronics & Automation Cluster and is a member of the steering committee at the Bavarian Science Forum (BayWiss). Additionally, Rohrmair serves as a scientific advisor for the Federal Ministry of Education and Research and the state government of North Rhine-Westphalia in the field of IT security/digitalization. In 2023, the National Polytechnic University of Odesa (ONPU) awarded Rohrmair an honorary doctorate. Since March 2024, he is deputy chairman of the Association of the Bavarian Universities of Applied Sciences.
