UAS4Europe and ERRIN are co-hosting a 'Horizon Europe Capacity-Building Workshop' on 6-7 November 2024 in Brussels.

During the two days, representatives from regional research and innovation ecosystems, including universities of applied sciences, policy-makers and public administrations will learn how to navigate within Horizon Europe's Pillar II. Participants will gain insights to help identify the right topics, build successful consortia and prepare applications for upcoming calls for proposals.

Day 1 will provide an overview of Horizon Europe and the Brussels-based research and innovation landscape. We will zoom in on Pillar II with a specific focus on consortium building and relevant tools for this purpose.

On day 2, the focus will be on preparing proposals in a dedicated session on how to deconstruct and analyse a call topic alongside insights on the award criteria and evaluation.

The sessions will include work in smaller groups allowing for networking opportunities and applying the knowledge gained from the presentations.

The target audience for this workshop is funding advisors, research managers, policymakers and public administrators from within the UAS4Europe and ERRIN networks.
